Individual School Sessions

- Each university hosts two 25-minute sessions of your choice. You know the strengths and selling points of your programs, so these are the spots to showcase them. We recommend hosting alumni interviews, information sessions, roundtables, or Q&As.
- We recommend having no more than 3 presenters for a single session.

Multi-School Panels

- Each university is asked to provide 1 panelist to join a 45-minute multi-school panel during the event. These panels focus on various topics, including the benefits of higher education, tips and tricks to navigate the application process, and helping candidates determine which school best suits their goals.
- Panels are moderated by a third party, such as a representative of GMAC, The MBA Tour, or a partner organization. Your panelist will be introduced to their moderator and fellow panelists via email one week before the event.

Virtual Booth

- Each participating school will have a virtual booth located in University Hall. This is a great place to chat with attendees and provide more information about your programs.
